# **SAPPHIRE GRAVEL**

Wash small amount of gravel in a sieve. Wet sapphires show up more easily under a bright light or sunlight. Watch for any colored stones that reflect light. Also look for red garnet and occasional gold nuggets. Hematite fossil clams and seedpods can also be found.
